2nd year NCATA Membership Scholarship

Eligible: 1st Year Agricultural Educators who paid their NCATA dues during their 1st year of service.

Purpose: To retain agricultural educators and encourage beginning teachers to be more active in the NCATA.

Award: The scholarship is in the amount of \$160 to be paid to the NCATA for the dues of the 2nd Year Agriculture Teacher. The Agriculture Teacher will be recognized at the Annual NCATA Awards Banquet during CTE Summer Conference in July.

Submission: Please submit the following documents electronically or by flash drive to the NCATA Awards committee by _____.

Criteria:

1. Narrative- The Narrative is limited to three 8 ½" X 11" pages. The narrative must be typed and using font no smaller than 12 point. Multiple text formats are acceptable, including paragraphs, lists, and tables. The narrative must follow the outline specified as follows:
 - a. Overview – brief description of your agricultural education program and the community in which your program exists.
 - b. Teaching Philosophy – a brief reflective statement (not to exceed one page) of your personal teaching philosophy.
 - c. NCATA Involvement- a brief description of how you have been involved in the NCATA (NCATA mentoring program, joining an NCATA committee, Fill the Bucket campaign, NCATA Winter Conference Attendance, etc) and how NCATA has helped you in your first year as an Agricultural Educator.
2. Letter of Reference- one letter of reference should be included with the application form. The letter of reference should be from the applicant's direct supervisor (principal, Career Tech Director, etc.). The letter of reference is not considered in the page limitations.
3. Photos- Should be showing instruction, experiential learning, student organizations, partnerships, or marketing - high resolution photos in .jpeg, .png, .bmp, .jpg, or .tif form can be submitted as part of your application. Limited to three 8 ½"X11" pages.
4. Professional Photo or Headshot - A high resolution photo in .gif, .jpeg, .png, .bmp, .jpg, or .tif form must be uploaded as part of the submission of your application.
5. Application Signature Page- the application signature page must be signed by the requested individuals and submitted with the application.
6. Checklist Sheet- Please include a completed checklist sheet with the application signed by the applicant.
